Currently, there are four specialty lens implants available which can be implanted during your cataract surgery. These implants have undergone extensive clinical trials and have been used worldwide for several years. Still, it should be noted that while these results have been excellent, everyone's eyes are different and results may vary.

Deluxe Multifocal Lens Implants. We're one of the few providers who offers all of them.

In the past, a monofocal intraocular lens has been the standard implant for cataract surgery. Its power is usually calculated to maximize a patient's distance vision so that the patient can see well enough to drive or watch TV but needed glasses to see close up or work on the computer.

Recently, the FDA approved three deluxe multifocal “accommodating” IOLs. These implant, which replace the natural lens in the same fashion as the monofocal lens, give good distance and near vision, thereby lessening dependence on glasses. Each of the three multifocal lenses have been optimized for a slightly different vision zone. Glendale Eye is one of the few centers certified to offer all three of these lenses: Crystalens, Restor and Rezoom. In addition, we offer a “deluxe” monofocal lens implant that corrects astigmatism.
